
(b) Necedah. Township 18 north, range 3 east, town of Necedah.






(1) Marathon county. (a)  $Beans\ Eddy$ . Township 26 north, range 6 east, town of Bergen.




(b) Townline reservoir. Township 26 north, range 6 east, town of Bergen.




(c) Honey Island Flowage. Township 26 north, range 5 east, town of Green Valley.




(d)  $McMillan\ Marsh.$  Township 26 north, range 2 east, town of Spencer and township 26 north, range 3 east, town of McMillan.




(e) Mead. Township 26 north, range 5 east, town of Green Valley.




(f) Steinke pond. Township 30 north, range 10 east, town of Harrison.



PROPOSED REFUGE BOUNDARY






(b) Tichigan wildlife area. Township 4 north, range 19 east, town of Waterford.


