(3) Columbia county. (a) $Pine\ Island$. Township 12 north, range 8 east, town of Caledonia.




(4) WAUKESHA COUNTY. (a) Big Muskego Lake. Township 5 north, range 20 east, town of Muskego.



(c) Honey Island Flowage. Township 26 north, range 5 east, town of Green Valley.


