SERB 4.01 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to establish a fee for persons required to file hazardous materials registration statements with the United States department of transportation under 49 USC Appendix 1805 (c), as required by s. 166.20 (7g), Stats.

SERB 4.02 Definitions. In this chapter:

(1) "Hazardous material" has the meaning given in 49 USC Appendix 1802 (4).

(2) "Person" has the meaning given in 49 USC Appendix 1802.

SERB 4.03 Hazardous materials transportation registration fee. (1) Any person required to file hazardous materials transportation registration statements with the United States department of transportation under 49 USC Appendix 1805 (c) shall pay a fee to the Wisconsin department of transportation. The calculation of the fee is determined by the number of activities the person engages within or through Wisconsin during the prior 12 month period of July 1 to June 80, and shall be paid by September 1, 1993. The fee shall be paid annually thereafter. The activities to be used in the calculation of the fee are as follows:

(a) Offers or transports in commerce on any highway route any controlled quantity of a class 7, radioactive material as specified under 49 CFR 173.403;

(b) Offers or transports in commerce more than 25 kilograms or 55 pounds of a division 1.1, 1.2 or 1.3 explosive material as specified under 49 CFR 173.50 in a motor vehicle, rail car or freight container;

(c) Offers or transports in commerce more than one liter or 1.06 quarts per package of a material extremely toxic by inhalation as specified under division 2.3, hazard zone A, or division 6.1, packing group I, hazard zone A as specified under 49 CFR 173.115 and 173.132;

(d) Offers or transports in commerce a hazardous material in a bulk packaging, as specified under 49 CFR 171.8, having a capacity equal to or greater than 13,248 liters or 3,500 gallons for liquids or gases or more than 13.24 cubic meters or 468 cubic feet for solids;

(e) Offers or transports in commerce a shipment in other than a bulk packaging of 2,268 kilograms or 5,000 pounds gross weight or more, of one class of hazardous materials for which placarding of a vehicle, rail car, or freight container is required for that class as specified under 49 CFR 172.500. The term "shipment" as used in the registration regula-

tions is limited to the hazardous material being offered or loaded at one loading facility.

(2) Except as provided under s. SERB 4.04, and using the calculation of activities under sub. (1) (a) to (e) the fee required under this section is:

(a) For persons engaged in one activity, \$400.

(b) For persons engaged in 2 activities, \$800.

(c) For persons engaged in 3 activities, \$1,200.

(d) For persons engaged in 4 activities, \$1,600.

(e) For persons engaged in 5 activities, \$2,000.

Multiple shipments within each category does not constitute a separate activity.

(3) Fees required under sub. (2) (a) to (e) do not apply to sub. (1) (a) to (e) after June 30, 1995.

SERB 4.04 Exemptions. If a person is required to pay the fee under s. 166.20 (7) (a) (2), Stats., the person shall pay under s. SERB 4.03 the amount by which the fee otherwise payable under s. SERB 4.03 exceeds the fee under s. 166.20 (7) (a)2, Stats., if any. For purposes of the fee exemption in this section, the reporting period under s. 166.20 (7) (a) (2) shall be the same as s. SERB 4.03.
