## **Chapter BC 9**

## RENEWAL AND REINSTATEMENT

BC 9.01 Restoration of license. BC 9.02 Reinstatement of license.

- **BC 9.01 Restoration of license.** Any person who held a license as a practitioner, manager, aesthetician, electrologist or manicurist and who failed to renew the license on or before the date of its expiration may renew the license as follows:
- (1) If the application for renewal is filed less than 30 days after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by payment of the fees specified in s. 440.08 (2) (a) 5., 18., 20., 30. or 46. and (3) (a) 1., Stats.
- (2) If the application for renewal is filed 30 days or more, but less than 5 years after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by payment of the fees speci-

- BC 9.02 Reinstatement of license. If the application for renewal is 5 years or more after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the board in its discretion may require as a condition of renewal that the applicant successfully pass the examination.
