LOTTERY AND GAMING CREDIT APPLICATION

You may claim the lottery and gaming credit for 1999 taxes, payable in 2000, if, on January 1,
1999, you were the owner of the property described in the box and used that property as your
primary residence. (Note: "primary residence" is defined below.) If you meet these
requirements, you may claim the credit by signing in the place indicated. If you return this form
byto the County Treasurer's Office, a lottery and gaming credit will be
shown on your December 1999 property tax bill. If you do not claim the credit using this form, no
credit will appear on the tax bill.

Do not return this form if you did not own the property on January 1, 1999, or if the property was not your primary residence on January 1, 1999.

General application for the Lottery and Gaming Credit will occur every 5 years. The next general application will occur in 2004. If you complete the application below, you will also be claiming a credit on your property tax bills in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 so long as the property continues to qualify. The property qualifies for the credit in each of those years if you own and use the property as your primary residence on January 1 of that year. For example, if you used the property as your primary residence on January 1, 1999, the property qualifies for the 1999 credit. If you continue to use the property as your primary residence on January 1, 2000, the property qualifies for the 2000 credit. If you sell the property any time after January 1, 2000, the property still qualifies for the 2000 credit, but you would not qualify for the credit in 2001, since you did not own and use it as your primary residence on January 1, 2001.

The law requires that you notify your county treasurer within 30 days after you no longer qualify to claim the credit either because you no longer own the property or no longer use it as your primary residence.
