## WCD 11.14 Closed area; waterfowl.

It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of migratory birds including waterfowl, at any time on the following described area:

(1) DODGE COUNTY (a) Horicon marsh state closed area. Township 12 north, range 16 east, town of Williamstown. All state-owned lands lying south of the east-west center line of sections 29 and 30 and east of the main ditch, said lands being situated in sections 29, 30, 31 and 32.

(3) WASHBURN COUNTY. (b) Mud Lake.

Township 37 north, range 10 west, town of Birchwood.

Section 6-All that part lying west of town road running generally north and south through said section.

Section 7-All that part lying north and west of town road running generally northeast and southwest through said section.
