



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 103**

May 23, 1995 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

1     **AN ACT to create** 115.76 (3) (k) of the statutes; **relating to:** specifying that  
2           significant developmental delay is a handicapping condition that may qualify  
3           certain children for special education and directing the department of public  
4           instruction to conduct inservice training.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

5           **SECTION 1.** 115.76 (3) (k) of the statutes is created to read:

6           115.76 (3) (k) For children who are 3, 4 or 5 years old, significant developmental  
7           delay.

8           **SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.**

9           (1) During the 1995-97 fiscal biennium the department of public instruction  
10          shall conduct inservice training for early childhood special education teachers and  
11          directors in identifying children with significant developmental delay to ensure that  
12          only children meeting the criteria established by the department by rule are so  
13          identified.
