1	Section 2. 20.370 (1) (es) of the statutes is created to read:
2	20.370 (1) (es) Parks and forests — Mountain Bay State Trail. From the
3	heritage state parks and forests trust fund, as a continuing appropriation, the
4	amounts in the schedule for the initial development and surfacing of the Mountain
5	Bay State Trail.
6	Section 3. 20.370 (1) (es) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act
7	(this act), is repealed.
8	Section 4. 27.016 (1) (a) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27,
9	is renumbered 27.016 (1) (am).
10	Section 5. 27.016 (1) (ag) of the statutes is created to read:

16	maintenance of the state park, southern state forest or state recreation area that the

18	Section 11. 27.016 (5) (b) and (c) of the statutes are created to read:
19	27.016 (5) (b) For the purpose of providing the matching funds, a friends group
20	may only use the following:
21	1. The interest generated by the endowment fund.
22	2. Collected revenues, subject to the requirement under par. (c).
23	(c) The amount of collected revenues that qualify under par. (b) 2. shall equal
24	the amount of collected revenues that the friends group deposits in its endowment
25	fund.

Section 12. 27.016 (7) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is repealed and recreated to read:

27.016 (7) (a) Beginning on July 1, 2001, from the appropriation under s. 20.370 (1) (eq), and after having encumbered and expended the amounts necessary for the grants approved under sub. (6), the department may in each fiscal year expend and encumber not more than \$50,000 for the operation and maintenance of state parks, southern state forests and state recreation areas.

(b) The department may not encumber or expend any moneys as authorized under par. (a) and sub. (6) if the encumbrance or expenditure will result in the heritage state parks and forests trust fund having an unencumbered balance of less than \$100,000 on June 30, 1997, or on any June 30 thereafter.

SECTION 13. Nonstatutory provisions; administration.

- (1) MOUNTAIN BAY STATE TRAIL INITIAL DEVELOPMENT. The department of administration shall ensure completion of the initial development and surfacing of the Mountain Bay State Trail no later than October 1, 1997.
- (2) Information for Biennial Budget Bill. Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, in submitting information under section 16.42 of the statutes for purposes of the 1997–99 biennial budget bill, the department of natural resources shall submit information concerning the appropriation under section 20.370 (1) (es) of the statutes, as created by the act, as though the amount appropriated to the department under section 20.370 (1) (es) of the statutes, as created by the act, for fiscal year 1996–97 had not been appropriated.
