## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1054

March 26, 1996 - Offered by Committee on Natural Resources.

1 AN ACT to amend 340.01 (2g) of the statutes; relating to: modifying the definition of all-terrain vehicle.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 340.01 (2g) of the statutes is amended to read:

340.01 (2g) "All-terrain vehicle" means an engine-driven device which has a net weight of 650 700 pounds or less, which has a width of 48 inches or less, which is equipped with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and which is designed to travel on 3 or more low-pressure tires. A low pressure tire is a tire which has a minimum width of 6 inches, which is designed to be mounted on a rim with a maximum diameter of 12 inches and which is designed to be inflated with an operating pressure not to exceed 6 pounds per square inch as recommended by the manufacturer.
