



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 14,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 13**

January 24, 1996 – Offered by Representative BAUMGART.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1. Page 1, line 3:** after “land” insert “and posting of certain public lands”.

3 **2. Page 1, line 4:** before that line insert:

4 “SECTION 1g. 24.41 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **24.41 Posting of certain public lands. (1)** (a) Except as provided in par.
6 (b), every board, commission, department and agency of the state having real estate
7 belonging to the state under its control shall post any boundary of the real estate as
8 specified in sub. (2) if the real estate abuts private land along that boundary.

9 (b) A board, commission, department or agency is not required to post a
10 boundary of real estate under its control under par. (a) if the abutting private land
11 is posted, in a manner that is substantially similar to the manner described in sub.
12 (2), with a sign that carries an appropriate notice that the land is private and the
13 name of the owner or occupant giving notice.

14 **(2)** A board, commission, department or agency shall post real estate under
15 sub. (1) (a) using one of the following procedures:

1 (a) Placing a sign at least 11 inches square in at least 2 conspicuous places for
2 every 150 yards of the boundary to be posted. The sign must carry an appropriate
3 notice that it marks the boundary between public and private land and the name of
4 the board, commission, department or agency that controls the real estate.

5 (b) Making markings of at least one foot long in at least 2 conspicuous places
6 for every 150 yards of the boundary to be posted, including in a contrasting color the
7 phrase "public land boundary" and the name of the board, commission, department
8 or agency that controls the real estate."

9 **3. Page 1, line 4:** delete "SECTION 1" and substitute "SECTION 1m".
