The department shall distribute 33% of the amounts 9 distributed under sub. The department 11 12shall distribute 34% of the amounts distributed under sub. (1) based on each county's 13 proportion of the number of total Part I juvenile offenses reported statewide under the uniform crime reporting system of the Wisconsin department office of justice 1415assistance, during the most recent 2-year period for which that information is 16 available.".

## "SECTION 9226. Appropriation changes; health and social services.

(1) CAPACITY BUILDING. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes
for the appropriation to the department of health and social services under section
20.435 (3) (f) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is
increased by \$2,500,000 for fiscal year 1995–96 and the dollar amount is increased
by \$2,500,000 for fiscal year 1996–97 to increase funding for the purpose for which
the appropriation is made.".
