



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 130**

September 21, 1995 - Offered by Senators RUDE, PANZER and HUELSMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 107, line 10: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 440m.** 118.125 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 118.125 (2) (c) The judge of any court of this state or of the United States shall,  
5 upon request, be provided by the school district clerk or his or her designee with a  
6 copy of all progress records of a pupil who is the subject of any proceeding in such  
7 court.”.

8 **2.** Page 107, line 12: after “clerk” insert “or his or her designee”.

9 **3.** Page 109, line 4: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 444m.** 118.125 (2) (i) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin  
11 Act 27, is amended to read:

12 118.125 (2) (i) Upon request, the school district clerk or his or her designee shall  
13 provide the names of pupils who have withdrawn from the public school prior to  
14 graduation under s. 118.15 (1) (c) to the technical college district board in which the

1 public school is located or, for verification of eligibility for public assistance under ch.  
2 49, to the department of health and social services, the department of industry, labor  
3 and human relations or a county department under s. 46.215, 46.22 or 46.23.

4 **SECTION 444r.** 118.125 (2) (j) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 118.125 (2) (j) 2. If a school has notified the parent, legal guardian or guardian  
6 ad litem that a pupil's name and address has been designated as directory data, has  
7 allowed 14 days for the parent, legal guardian or guardian ad litem of the pupil to  
8 inform the school that the pupil's name and address may not be released without the  
9 prior consent of the parent, legal guardian or guardian ad litem and the parent, legal  
10 guardian or guardian ad litem has not so informed the school, the school district clerk  
11 or his or her designee, upon request, shall provide a technical college district board  
12 with the name and address of each such pupil who is expected to graduate from high  
13 school in the current school year.”.

14 **4.** Page 109, line 12: after “clerk” insert “or his or her designee”.
