2 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

3 **1.** Page 225, line 10: after that line insert:

4 “(6) COMMUNICATION TO A JURY. In jury trials under this chapter, the guardian
5 ad litem or the court may tell the jury that the guardian ad litem represents the
6 interests of the person for whom the guardian ad litem was appointed.”.

7 **2.** Page 230, line 14: after “court” insert “or jury”.

8 **3.** Page 230, line 18: after that line insert:

9 “(g) The right to a jury trial, if the petition reserves the right under s. 938.255
10 (1) (d) to recommend a disposition under s. 938.34 (3) (d) or (f), (4h), (4m) or (6) (am).”.

11 **4.** Page 240, line 17: delete “as well as” and substitute a comma.

12 **5.** Page 240, line 19: before the period insert: “, and a statement whether the
petitioner is reserving the right to recommend a disposition under s. 938.34 (3) (d)
or (f), (4h), (4m) or (6) (am)”.
