ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 11, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 150

June 20, 1995 – Offered by Representatives Plombon, Wilder, Dueholm, Ryba, Vander Loop, Gronemus and Springer.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 207, line 4: after that line insert:
3	"(ae) Equity aid GPR A -0- 24,000,000
4	".
5	2. Page 367, line 22: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 581g. 20.255 (2) (ae) of the statutes is created to read:
7	20.255 (2) (ae) Equity aid. The amounts in the schedule for the payment of
8	equity aid to eligible school districts under s. 121.082.".
9	3. Page 1399, line 6: delete the underscored material and restore the stricken
	material.
10	4. Page 1399, line 7: before that line insert:
11	"SECTION 4068m. 121.082 of the statutes is created to read:
12	121.082 Equity aid. (1) A school district is eligible for equity aid under this
13	section if all of the following apply:

(a) In the previous school year the net cost of the general fund divided by its
 membership was less than 92% of the statewide average.

3 (b) In the previous school year, the equalized value of the school district divided
4 by its membership was less than the statewide average.

5 (2) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ae), beginning in the 1996–97 6 school year, the state shall pay to each school district eligible for aid under this 7 section the amount necessary to ensure that the net cost of the school district's 8 general fund divided by its membership is equal to 92% of the statewide average.".
