ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 22, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 150

June 20, 1995 – Offered by Representatives Notestein, Grobschmidt, R. Young, Bock and Turner.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 1371, line 4: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 3971d. 118.30 (1r) of the statutes is created to read:
4	118.30 (1r) Each private school participating in the program under s. 119.23
5	shall also administer the 4th, 8th and 10th grade examinations and performance
6	assessments, as described under sub. (1m), to the pupils enrolled in the private
7	school in the appropriate grades.".
8	2. Page 1371, line 9: on lines 9, 11, and 16, after "board" insert " <u>or private</u>
	<u>school</u> ".
9	3. Page 1384, line 19: after that line insert:
10	"SECTION 4002m. 119.23 (2) (a) 6. of the statutes is created to read:
11	119.23 (2) (a) 6. The private school has a formally constituted governing
12	board.".
13	4. Page 1386, line 3: after that line insert:

1	"SECTION 4007p. 119.23 (6m) of the statutes is created to read:
2	119.23 (6m) (a) Each private school participating in the program under this
3	section shall do all of the following:
4	1. Annually administer a standardized reading test developed by the
5	department to all pupils in the program who are enrolled in the 3rd grade.
6	2. Annually distribute to the parent or guardian of each pupil in the program
7	a report that includes information on the pupil's performance on the test under subd.
8	1. and the examinations administered under s. 118.30.
9	3. Annually provide for an independent financial audit of the private school.
10	(b) The department shall monitor the compliance of private schools with par.
11	(a) and s. 118.30. If the department determines in any school year that the private
12	school has violated par. (a) or s. 118.30, the private school may not participate in the
13	program under this section in the following school year.".
