The lapse shall be from the appropriation accounts from which the division administrators' compensation is paid and the amount of the lapse that is taken from each appropriation account shall equal the amount of compensation of each division administrator that is paid from that account. The secretary of administration shall transfer to the general fund on October 1, 1995, an amount that equals the compensation of all division administrators' in the unclassified service during the 1995–96 fiscal year that is derived from segregated revenue. The transfer shall be from the appropriation accounts from which the division administrators' compensation is paid and the

amount of the transfer that is made from each appropriation account shall equal the amount of compensation of each division administrator that is paid from that account.

(b) The secretary of administration shall lapse to the general fund on October 1, 1996, an amount that equals the compensation of all division administrators in the unclassified service during the 1996–97 fiscal year that is derived from general purpose revenue or program revenue. The lapse shall be from the appropriation accounts from which the division administrators' compensation is paid and the amount of the lapse that is taken from each appropriation account shall equal the amount of compensation of each division administrator that is paid from that account. The secretary of administration shall transfer to the general fund on October 1, 1996, an amount that equals the compensation of all division administrators in the unclassified service during the 1996–97 fiscal year that is derived from segregated revenue. The transfer shall be from the appropriation accounts from which the division administrators' compensation is paid and the amount of the transfer that is made from each appropriation account shall equal the amount of compensation of each division administrator that is paid from that account."

**38.** Page 2498, line 14: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 2499, line 2, and substitute (and adjust the appropriate totals accordingly):

"Capitol south wing renovation and restoration \$16,540,000

- 9 (b) The secretary shall determine for each state agency the amount expended 10 by the state agency for limited term appointments in the 1994–95 fiscal year.
  - (c) No state agency may make total expenditures in the 1995–96 fiscal year or the 1996–97 fiscal year for limited term appointments exceeding 90% of the total amount expended by the agency for that purpose in the 1994–95 fiscal year.
  - (d) Notwithstanding section 16.50 (1) (a) and (2) of the statutes, the secretary shall require submission of expenditure estimates under section 16.50 (1) of the statutes for all expenditures to be made by any state agency for limited term appointments and shall withhold approval of any estimate for expenditures to be made in violation of paragraph (c).".
