



**SENATE AMENDMENT 16,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 150**

June 27, 1995 – Offered by Senators C. POTTER and MOORE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

2 **1. Page 270, line 1:** substitute “system” for “program”; and increase the dollar
amount for fiscal year 1995–96 by \$187,500 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal
year 1996–97 by \$187,500 to increase funding for the purposes for which the
appropriation is made.

3 **2. Page 270, line 5:** increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1995–96 by
\$205,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1996–97 by \$250,000 to
increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

4 **3. Page 436, line 6:** delete lines 6 to 10.

5 **4. Page 1532, line 19:** delete the material beginning with that line and ending
with page 1533, line 11, and substitute:

6 “**SECTION 4370k.** 146.57 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 146.57 (3) (a) ~~By July 1, 1994, the~~ The department shall designate no more than
8 2 regional poison control centers and shall implement any other aspects of a
9 statewide poison control system. From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (ds), the

1 department shall, if the requirement under par. (b) is met, distribute, ~~for fiscal year~~
2 ~~1994-95~~, not more than \$187,500 in each fiscal year to each regional poison control
3 center that is so designated to supplement the operation of the centers and to provide
4 for the statewide collection and reporting of poison control data by the centers.”.

5 **5.** Page 2074, line 18: delete lines 18 to 20 and substitute: “From the
appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (ef), the department shall award ~~the following~~
~~grants to~~ grants for the following purposes, including a grant of \$205,000 in each
fiscal year to local health departments, under criteria that the department shall
establish in rules promulgated under this section:
