## SENATE AMENDMENT 38, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 150

June 27, 1995 – Offered by Senator Adelman.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 163, line 2: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 464b. 19.82 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
4	19.82 (4) "Partisan caucus" means a gathering of members of a governmental
5	body who are members of the same political party.".
6	<b>2.</b> Page 163, line 15: after that line insert:
7	"SECTION 464g. 19.87 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	19.87 Legislative meetings. (intro.) This subchapter shall apply to all
9	meetings of the senate and assembly and the partisan caucuses, committees,
10	subcommittees and other subunits thereof, except that:
11	SECTION 464h. 19.87 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
12	19.87 (2) No provision of this subchapter which conflicts with a rule of the
13	senate or assembly or joint rule of the legislature shall apply to a meeting conducted
14	in compliance with such rule. <u>No such rule may exempt a partisan caucus from any</u>
15	provision of this subchapter.

<b>SECTION 464i.</b>	19.87 (3) of the statutes is repealed.".
