## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 166

June 20, 1995 – Offered by Senator ADELMAN.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
	amendment 1, as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 1, line 2: after "gasoline" insert ", the sale of reformulated gasoline".
3	<b>2.</b> Page 1, line 4: delete lines 4 and 5 and substitute:
4	"SECTION 1. 144.3716 of the statutes is repealed.
5	<b>SECTION 1e.</b> 168.04 of the statutes is amended to read:
6	168.04 Standards. The department by rule shall prescribe minimum product
7	grade specifications for gasoline <del>, reformulated gasoline, as defined in s. 144.3716 (1),</del>
8	and kerosene and may prescribe product grade specifications for automotive
9	gasoline, gasoline-alcohol fuel blends, aviation gasoline, fuel oils and diesel fuels.
10	Automotive gasoline specifications shall include lead content. The rules shall, to the
11	extent feasible, be in conformity with nationally recognized standards, specifications
12	and classifications, such as those published by the American society for testing and
13	materials, the society of automotive engineers and the U.S. environmental
14	protection agency. The department may not promulgate or enforce a rule prohibiting
15	additional information from placement on the dispensing device.

1 SECTION 1r. 168.11 (1) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 168.11 (1) (b) 1m. and 2 amended to read:".
