



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 194**

October 26, 1995 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “on” insert “and photographs taken for”.

3 **2.** Page 1, line 4: delete “SECTION 1” and substitute:

4 “SECTION 1g. 343.14 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 343.14 (3) The department shall, as part of the application process, take a
6 photograph of the applicant to comply with s. 343.17 (3) (a) 2. Except where
7 specifically exempted by statute or by rule of the department, no application may be
8 processed without the photograph being taken and, prior to the photograph being
9 taken, the applicant surrendering any valid operator’s license issued to the applicant
10 in his or her possession or, except as provided in s. 343.11 (1), presenting another
11 form of identification acceptable to the department. In the case of renewal licenses,
12 the photograph shall be taken once every 4 years, and shall coincide with the
13 appearance for examination which is required under s. 343.16 (3). The department
14 may make provision for issuance of a license without a photograph if the applicant
15 is stationed outside the state in military service and in specific situations where the
16 department deems such action appropriate.
