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## SENATE AMENDMENT 3, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 21

March 29, 1995 - Offered by Joint Committee on Finance.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 12, line 1: delete lines 1 to 10 and substitute:
- "(7) Joint committee on finance program supplementation. Notwithstanding sections 13.101 (3) (a) and 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes, the joint committee on finance may expend any increase in the appropriation under section 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes made under Section 13 (14) of this act, without making any of the findings required under sections 13.101 (3) (a) and 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes, to supplement any appropriations under section 20.435 (1) (b) and (4) (a), (br), (de) and (df) of the statutes for the purposes for which those appropriations are made.".
- **2.** Page 12, line 12: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 14, line 21, as affected by assembly amendment 7.
  - **3.** Page 15, line 25: after that line insert:
- "(13) Medical assistance waiver savings. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health and social services under section 20.435 (1) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is decreased by \$1,464,700 for fiscal year 1996–97 to reflect

savings in medical assistance benefit costs because of the waivers under sections 49.19 (11s) and 49.193 (3m) and (9m) of the statutes.

(14) Joint committee on finance program supplementation. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the joint committee on finance under section 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$2,337,000 for fiscal year 1995–96 and the dollar amount is increased by \$2,986,600 for fiscal year 1996–97 to supplement any appropriations under section 20.435 (1) (b) and (4) (a), (br), (de) and (df) of the statutes to reflect the approval or denial of the waivers under section 49.193 (3m) and (9m) of the statutes."
