| 2  | ${f 1.}$ Page 5, line 9: delete lines 9 to 11 and substitute: "the department.                                  |
| 3  | Paragraphs (b) to (d) apply only while a waiver under this paragraph is in effect and                           |
| 4  | only with respect to recipients covered by the waiver.  |
| 5  | (am) Notwithstanding par. (a), the department may not do any of the following:                                  |
| 6  | 1. Apply the waiver to any person who is subject to s. 49.25.   |
| 7  | 2. Operate the demonstration project before the department has submitted the                                    |
| 8  | study required under this paragraph. The department shall study the adequacy of                                 |
| 9  | the standard of need under sub. (4) (es) and the standard of assistance under sub.                              |
| 10 | $\left( 11\right) \left( a\right) .$ In studying the adequacy of these standards, the department shall consider |
| 11 | whether these standards are sufficient to provide families with dependent children                              |
| 12 | with clothing, transportation and safe and adequate food and housing. The report                                |
| 13 | required under this paragraph shall be submitted to the legislature under s. 13.172                             |
| 14 | (3).".  |
