TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 36**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 9: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 12m.** 893.55 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

4 893.55 (7) Evidence of any compensation for bodily injury received from  
5 sources other than the defendant to compensate the claimant for the injury is  
6 admissible in an action to recover damages for medical malpractice. This section  
7 does not limit the substantive or procedural rights of persons who have claims based  
8 upon subrogation.”.
