1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 23: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 13m.** 11.30 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 11.30 (5) Whenever any person receives payment from another person, in cash
5 or in-kind, for the direct or indirect cost of conducting a poll concerning support or
6 opposition to a candidate, political party or referendum, the person conducting the
7 poll shall, upon request of any person who is polled, disclose to the person who is
8 polled the name and address of the person making payment for the poll and, in the
9 case of a registrant under s. 11.05, the name of the treasurer of the person making
10 payment, before making any other communication with the person who is polled.”.
