

## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 21, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 37

## February 17, 1995 – Offered by Representatives Baldus, Plombon, Walker, Bock, Wilder, Notestein, Bell and Baldwin.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 7, line 15: after that line insert:
3	<b>"SECTION 12m.</b> 11.30 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	11.30 (5) Whenever any person is authorized to conduct by a person, committee
5	or group who or which is subject to a registration requirement under s. 11.05, and
6	<u>contracts to receive or</u> receives payment from <del>another</del> <u>any such</u> person <u>, committee</u>
7	or group, in cash or in-kind, for the direct or indirect cost of conducting, a poll
8	concerning support or opposition to a candidate, political party or referendum <u>that</u>
9	is conducted within 60 days before an election, the person conducting the poll shall,
10	no later than the conclusion of each polling communication and at any time upon
11	request of any person who is polled, disclose the name <del>and address</del> of the person <u>,</u>
12	committee or group authorizing the poll to be conducted, and the name of the person,
13	<u>committee or group</u> making payment for the poll <del>and, in the case of a registrant under</del>

- 1 s. 11.05, the name of the treasurer of the person making payment <u>if different from</u>
- 2 <u>the person, committee or group authorizing the poll to be conducted</u>.".
