



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 6,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 399**

September 28, 1995 - Offered by Representatives HUBER, WALKER, WOOD, UNDERHEIM, KLUSMAN, ZIEGELBAUER and GROBSCHMIDT.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 14: delete the material beginning with the underscored comma and ending with “medication” on page 3, line 1, and substitute: “and the pain or discomfort cannot be alleviated through pain relief measures”.

2. Page 7, line 6: delete the material beginning with “to” and ending with “medication” on line 8, and substitute: “withholding or withdrawing life-sustaining procedures or feeding tubes would cause the patient pain or reduced comfort and that the pain or discomfort cannot be alleviated through pain relief measures”.
