



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 469**

January 17, 1996 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 23: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 8m.** 343.50 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 343.50 **(4m)** ORGAN DONOR INFORMATION. (a) As part of every application for an
5 identification card, the department shall inquire whether the applicant desires to be
6 an organ donor. The department shall record the organ donor response in its file of
7 the person.

8 (b) In addition to the inquiry under par. (a), if the applicant is at least 18 years
9 of age, the department shall orally state to the applicant that he or she has the
10 opportunity to indicate his or her willingness to be an organ donor. If the applicant
11 indicates that he or she is undecided in response to the inquiry under par. (a), the
12 department shall provide the applicant with written information that all organ
13 procurement organizations and the department have together developed. If the
14 applicant makes an affirmative response to the inquiry under par. (a), the
15 department shall request at that time that the applicant write on the identification

1 card the information that is required to make an anatomical gift under s. 157.06 (2)

2 (b) and (c) and affix a sticker thereto as provided in s. 343.175 (3).”
