



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 470**

September 7, 1995 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete “and” and substitute a comma.

3 **2.** Page 1, line 5: before the period insert: “and making an appropriation”.

4 **3.** Page 2, line 5: delete “\$65,000” and substitute “\$75,000”.

5 **4.** Page 2, line 7: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 1m.** 48.551 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Acts 27
7 and ... (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

8 48.551 (1) The department shall establish a state adoption center for the
9 purposes of increasing public knowledge of adoption and promoting to adolescents
10 and pregnant women the availability of adoption services. From the appropriation
11 under s. 20.435 (3) (dg), the department may provide not more than \$75,000 in grants
12 in each fiscal year to individuals and private agencies to operate the adoption
13 center.”.

14 **5.** Page 4, line 10: after that line insert:

15 “**SECTION 7m. Appropriation changes; health and social services.**

1 (1) STATE ADOPTION CENTER.

2 (a) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
3 to the department of health and social services under section 20.435 (6) (dg) of the
4 statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$10,000
5 for fiscal year 1995-96 to increase funding for the purpose for which the
6 appropriation is made.

7 (b) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
8 to the department of health and social services under section 20.435 (3) (dg) of the
9 statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$10,000
10 for fiscal year 1996-97 to increase funding for the purpose for which the
11 appropriation is made.

12 **SECTION 7p. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after
13 publication, except as follows:

14 (1) STATE ADOPTION CENTER. The repeal and recreation of section 48.551 (1) of
15 the statutes takes effect on July 1, 1996.”.
