



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 511**

November 29, 1995 - Offered by Representative NASS.

1 **AN ACT to create** 48.78 (2) (g) and 938.78 (2) (g) of the statutes; **relating to:** the  
2 disclosure by a social services agency of information about an individual in the  
3 care or legal custody of the social services agency.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4 **SECTION 1.** 48.78 (2) (g) of the statutes is created to read:  
5 48.78 (2) (g) Paragraph (a) does not prohibit an agency from disclosing  
6 information about an individual in its care or legal custody on the written request  
7 of the department of regulation and licensing or of any interested examining board  
8 or affiliated credentialing board in that department for use in any investigation or  
9 proceeding relating to any alleged misconduct by any person who is credentialed or  
10 who is seeking credentialing under ch. 448, 455 or 457. Unless authorized by an  
11 order of the court, the department of regulation and licensing and any examining  
12 board or affiliated credentialing board in that department shall keep confidential  
13 any information obtained under this paragraph and may not disclose the name of or  
14 any other identifying information about the individual who is the subject of the

1 information disclosed, except to the extent that redisclosure of that information is  
2 necessary for the conduct of the investigation or proceeding for which that  
3 information was obtained.

4 **SECTION 2.** 938.78 (2) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

5 938.78 (2) (g) Paragraph (a) does not prohibit an agency from disclosing  
6 information about an individual in its care or legal custody on the written request  
7 of the department of regulation and licensing or of any interested examining board  
8 or affiliated credentialing board in that department for use in any investigation or  
9 proceeding relating to any alleged misconduct by any person who is credentialed or  
10 who is seeking credentialing under ch. 448, 455 or 457. Unless authorized by an  
11 order of the court, the department of regulation and licensing and any examining  
12 board or affiliated credentialing board in that department shall keep confidential  
13 any information obtained under this paragraph and may not disclose the name of or  
14 any other identifying information about the individual who is the subject of the  
15 information disclosed, except to the extent that redisclosure of that information is  
16 necessary for the conduct of the investigation or proceeding for which that  
17 information was obtained.
