



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 516**

March 6, 1996 – Offered by Representative WALKER.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 134.66 (5); *to amend* 48.983 (5) and 134.66
2 (4) (a) 1.; and *to create* 134.66 (5) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** the authority
3 of counties, towns, villages and cities to enact ordinances regulating the
4 purchase, possession, sale or giving of cigarettes and tobacco products.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 48.983 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
6 48.983 (5) A county, town, village or city may ~~adopt~~ enact an ordinance
7 regulating the ~~conduct regulated by this section only if it strictly conforms to~~
8 purchase or possession of cigarettes or tobacco products by a child, if the ordinance
9 is at least as strict as this section. A county ordinance ~~adopted~~ enacted under this
10 section does not apply within any town, village or city that has ~~adopted or adopts~~
11 enacted or enacts an ordinance under this subsection.
