



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 3,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 591**

March 7, 1996 - Offered by Representative GRONEMUS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 21: after "age," insert: "the number of children for whom a
3 person may provide care and supervision before the person is required to obtain a
4 license to operate a day care center,".

5 **2.** Page 25, line 14: after that line insert:

6 "SECTION 61g. 46.986 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 46.986 (1) (d) "Day care center" means a facility operated by a child care
8 provider that provides care and supervision for ~~4~~ 6 or more children under 7 years
9 of age for less than 24 hours a day."

10 **3.** Page 36, line 8: after that line insert:

11 "SECTION 71j. 48.65 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

12 48.65 (1) No person may for compensation provide care and supervision for ~~4~~
13 6 or more children under the age of 7 for less than 24 hours a day unless that person
14 obtains a license to operate a day care center from the department. To obtain a

1 license under this subsection to operate a day care center, a person must meet the
2 minimum requirements for a license established by the department under s. 48.67
3 and pay the license fee under sub. (3). A license issued under this subsection is valid
4 for 2 years after the date of issuance, unless sooner revoked or suspended.”.

5 **4.** Page 42, line 22: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 71r.** 48.65 (3) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act
7 27, is amended to read:

8 48.65 **(3)** (a) Before the department may issue a license under sub. (1) to a day
9 care center that provides care and supervision for ~~4~~ 6 to 8 children, the day care
10 center must pay to the department a biennial fee of \$50. Before the department may
11 issue a license under sub. (1) to a day care center that provides care and supervision
12 for 9 or more children, the day care center must pay to the department a biennial fee
13 of \$25, plus a biennial fee of \$7 per child, based on the number of children that the
14 day care center is licensed to serve. A day care center that wishes to renew a license
15 issued under sub. (1) shall pay the applicable fee under this paragraph by the
16 renewal date of the license. A new day care center shall pay the applicable fee under
17 this paragraph no later than 30 days before the opening of the day care center.”.
