



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 591**

March 13, 1996 – Offered by Senators C. POTTER, GROBSCHMIDT, BRESKE, SHIBILSKI, BURKE, CHVALA, CLAUSING, ANDREA, DECKER, RISSER, MOEN, WINEKE, JAUCH, MOORE and GEORGE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 3, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 75, line 1: delete “par. (at)”, as affected by chief clerk’s correction, and
4 substitute “pars. (at) and (au)”.

5 **2.** Page 75, line 3: delete “A” and substitute: “Except as provided in par. (au),
6 a”.

7 **3.** Page 75, line 11: after that line insert:

8 “(au) *Postsecondary education.* A participant may fulfill the hours of
9 participation requirement under par. (as), in whole or in part, through participation
10 in a self-initiated postsecondary education program if the Wisconsin works agency
11 determines that the program is likely to be completed within a 24-month period, that
12 the participant is participating satisfactorily and that the program is likely to lead
13 to employment. A Wisconsin works agency may not require a participant under this
14 paragraph to work in a community service job in excess of the number of hours equal
15 to the difference between 40 hours and the number of classroom hours that the

1 participant spends in the postsecondary education program. The department shall
2 define by rule satisfactory participation in postsecondary education.”.

3 **4.** Page 77, line 20: delete “par. (bt)” and substitute “pars. (bt) and (bu)”.

4 **5.** Page 77, line 22: delete “A” and substitute: “Except as provided in par. (bu),
5 a”.

6 **6.** Page 78, line 6: after that line insert:

7 “(bu) *Postsecondary education.* A participant may fulfill the hours of
8 participation requirement under par. (bs), in whole or in part, through participation
9 in a self-initiated postsecondary education program if the Wisconsin works agency
10 determines that the program is likely to be completed within a 24-month period, that
11 the participant is participating satisfactorily and that the program is likely to lead
12 to employment. A Wisconsin works agency may not require a participant under this
13 paragraph to engage in activities under par. (b) 1. in excess of the number of hours
14 equal to the difference between 40 hours and the number of classroom hours that the
15 participant spends in the postsecondary education program. The department shall
16 define by rule satisfactory participation in postsecondary education.”.
