



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 16,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 69**

October 2, 1995 – Offered by Representative RILEY.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 19: after that line insert:

“(c) Subsection (2) does not apply in any city with a population of more than 180,000 if, in 1993 or any year thereafter, the percentage of homicides committed in the city with a firearm exceeds 50% of all homicides committed in the city during the year.

(d) No ordinance or resolution that is enacted or adopted under sub. (2) or which is subject to par. (a) applies to or may be enforced against an individual who is traveling directly through the political subdivision in which the ordinance or resolution is in effect if the individual is a nonresident of that political subdivision and if the firearm is unloaded and encased while the individual is in the political subdivision.”.
