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SENATE AMENDMENT 13, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 69

November 9, 1995 - Offered by Senator WINEKE.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 1, line 2: after "counties" insert ", the carrying of firearms in certain public places and providing a penalty".
 - **2.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

"Section 1e. 48.78 (3) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, section 2614m, is amended to read:

48.78 (3) If a child adjudged delinquent on the basis of a violation of s. 941.10, 941.11, 941.20, 941.21, 941.23, 941.235, 941.236, 941.237, 941.24, 941.26, 941.28, 941.295, 941.298, 941.30, 941.31, 941.32, 941.325, 943.02, 943.03, 943.04, 943.10 (2) (a), 943.23 (1g), (1m) or (1r), 943.32 (2), 948.02, 948.025, 948.03, 948.05, 948.055, 948.60, 948.605 or 948.61 or any crime specified in ch. 940 has escaped from a secured correctional facility, has been allowed to leave a secured correctional facility for a specified time period and is absent from the facility for more than 12 hours after the expiration of the specified period or has run away from the child's placement in the community while under corrective sanctions supervision, the department may release the child's name and any information about the child that is necessary for the

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protection of the public or to secure the child's return to the facility or placement.

The department shall promulgate rules establishing guidelines for the release of the

child's name or information about the child to the public.

Section 1f. 48.78 (3) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, section 2614p, and 1995 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed and recreated to read: 48.78 (3) If a child adjudged delinguent on the basis of a violation of s. 941.10. 941.11, 941.20, 941.21, 941.23, 941.235, 941.236, 941.237, 941.24, 941.26, 941.28, 941.295, 941.298, 941.30, 941.31, 941.32, 941.325, 943.02, 943.03, 943.04, 943.10 (2) (a), 943.23 (1g), (1m) or (1r), 943.32 (2), 948.02, 948.025, 948.03, 948.05, 948.055, 948.60, 948.605 or 948.61 or any crime specified in ch. 940 has escaped from a secured correctional facility, has been allowed to leave a secured correctional facility for a specified time period and is absent from the facility for more than 12 hours after the expiration of the specified period or has run away from the child's placement in the community while under corrective sanctions or serious juvenile offender supervision, the department of corrections may release the child's name and any information about the child that is necessary for the protection of the public or to secure the child's return to the facility or placement. The department of corrections shall promulgate rules establishing guidelines for the release of the child's name or information about the child to the public.".

- **3.** Page 1, line 3: delete "1" and substitute "1m".
- **4.** Page 3, line 2: after that line insert:

"Section 2g. 939.632 (1) (e) 3. of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 22, is amended to read:

7	(2) (a) In this subsection, "municipality" means a city, village, town or county.
8	(b) Any person who goes armed with a firearm in a street, road, highway,
9	sidewalk, alley or other property of a municipality is subject to a Class D forfeiture.
10	(3) This section does not apply to peace officers or armed forces or military
11	personnel who go armed in the line of duty or to any person duly authorized by the
12	chief of police of any city, village or town, the chief of the capitol police or the sheriff
13	of any county to possess a firearm in any place under sub. (1) or (2).
14	SECTION 2x. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after
15	publication, except as follows:
16	(1) The amendment of section 48.78 (3) of the statutes takes effect on December
17	1, 1995, or on the day after publication, whichever is later.
18	(2) The repeal and recreation of section 48.78 (3) of the statutes takes effect on
19	July 1, 1996.".
