



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 762**

February 13, 1996 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON TOURISM AND RECREATION.

1 **AN ACT to renumber** 27.01 (8) (d) (title); **to renumber and amend** 27.01 (8) (d);
2 and **to create** 27.01 (8m) (a) 2. and 27.01 (8m) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:**
3 collection of admission fees to state trails and Heritage Hill State Park.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 27.01 (8) (d) (title) of the statutes is renumbered 27.01 (8m) (title).

5 **SECTION 2.** 27.01 (8) (d) of the statutes is renumbered 27.01 (8m) (a) (intro.) and
6 amended to read:

7 27.01 (**8m**) (a) (intro.) The department may authorize agents, including the
8 department's concessionaires and their agents, to collect the admission fees ~~and to~~
9 under sub. (8) as follows:

10 1. Agents who are managers and operators of state trails, and who incur actual
11 operating expenses, may retain not more than 20% 70% of the admission fees
12 collected by them that they collect.

13 (c) The department shall regulate ~~their~~ the activities of agents under this
14 subsection in a manner similar to s. 29.09.
