



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 810**

March 6, 1996 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 9: delete lines 9 to 14 and substitute:

3 “111.81 (13) (b) Any attorney who serves in the office of a constitutional officer  
4 specified in s. 15.02 (1) or in a department, as defined in s. 15.01 (5), or an  
5 independent agency, as defined in s. 15.01 (9), and who is designated by his or her  
6 appointing authority as the chief legal counsel.

7 **SECTION 2m.** 111.81 (13) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

8 111.81 (13) (c) Any attorney who serves in the office of a constitutional officer  
9 specified in s. 15.02 (1) or in a department, as defined in s. 15.01 (5), or an  
10 independent agency, as defined in s. 15.01 (9), and who is designated by his or her  
11 appointing authority as the deputy chief legal counsel, but only if the office,  
12 department or independent agency employs a total of 6 or more full-time equivalent  
13 attorney positions.”.
