March 28, 1996 - Offered by Senator Clausing.

1	AN ACT to amend chapter 942 (title); and to create 942.08 of the statutes;
2	relating to: criminal invasion of privacy and providing a penalty.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	Section 1. Chapter 942 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	CHAPTER 942
5	CRIMES AGAINST REPUTATION,
6	PRIVACY AND CIVIL LIBERTIES
7	Section 2. 942.08 of the statutes is created to read:
8	942.08 Invasion of privacy. (1) In this section:
9	(a) "Nude or partially nude person" means any human being who has less than
10	fully and opaquely covered genitals, pubic area or buttocks, any female human being
11	who has less than a fully opaque covering over any portion of a breast below the top
12	of the nipple, or any male human being with covered genitals in a discernibly turgid

- (c) "Surveillance device" means any device, instrument, apparatus, implement, mechanism or contrivance used, designed to be used or primarily intended to be used to engage in surveillance, including a peep hole or similar method of direct sight observation.
- (2) Whoever knowingly installs or uses a surveillance device in any place for the purpose of engaging in surveillance of any nude or partially nude person is guilty of a Class E felony.
