## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 869

March 27, 1996 - Offered by Senators Weeden and Cowles.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 1, line 11: delete that line and substitute:
3	"Section 1b. 20.115 (7) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	20.115 (7) (e) Agricultural chemical cleanup program; general fund. As a
5	continuing appropriation, the The amounts in the schedule for reimbursement of
6	corrective action costs under s. 94.73.
7	<b>Section 1g.</b> 20.115 (7) (e) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act
8	(this act), is amended to read:
9	20.115 (7) (e) Agricultural chemical cleanup program; general fund. The
10	amounts in the schedule for reimbursement of corrective action costs under s. 94.73.
11	Notwithstanding s. 20.001 (3) (a), any unencumbered balance on June 30 of each year
12	shall be transferred to the property tax relief fund under s. 25.62.
13	<b>Section 1m.</b> 25.46 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:".
14	2. Page 9, line 5: after that line insert:

1	"(1p) Reconciliation; transfer to property tax relief fund. If 1995 Wisconsin
2	Act (Assembly Bill 808) is not enacted into law, the treatment of section 20.115 (7)
3	(e) (by Section 1g) of the statutes and Section 32 (1q) of this act are void.
4	SECTION 32. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication,
5	except as follows:
6	(1p) The treatment of section 20.115 (7) (e) by (Section 1b) of the statutes takes
7	effect on June 29, 1996.
8	(1q) The treatment of section 20.115 (7) (e) (by Section 1g) of the statutes takes
9	effect on June 30, 1996.".
