



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 951**

March 12, 1996 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON SMALL BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 21: delete lines 21 to 25 and substitute:

3 “(b) The state promotions board may not have any rights and authority over the  
4 commercial use of any of the following:

5 1. Any state symbol or representation to which the state does not possess the  
6 rights and authority.

7 2. Any state symbol or representation that relates to the University of  
8 Wisconsin System.

9 3. Any state symbol or representation described in ss. 1.07, 1.08 and 1.10.

10 4. Any state symbol or representation that relates to the state historical society.

11 5. Any label or trademark adopted under s. 100.14.

12 6. Any state symbol or representation that relates to the state lottery under ch.  
13 565.

14 7. Any brand, label, mark or tag that contains the words “convict-made”, as  
15 provided under s. 132.13 (1) (a).”.
