ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 37

November 8, 1995 - Offered by Representative Ziegelbauer.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ **1.** Page 1, line 4: after "sheriffs" insert: "and limiting the number of 3 consecutive terms permitted for sheriffs". **2.** Page 1, line 16: after that line insert: 4 5 "Section 2m. Section 4 (1) (c) of article VI of the constitution is created to read: 6 [Article VI] Section 4 (1) (c) Beginning with the terms commencing after 2000, 7 a person may not serve more than 3 consecutive 4-year terms as a sheriff. Time 8 served during an initial partial term shall not be counted as part of the 12-year limit. 9 Terms are consecutive unless they are more than 2 years apart.".
