SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 82

March 5, 1996 - Offered by Senator MOEN.

1	Relating to: the life and public service of Karl J. Goethel.
2	Whereas, Karl J. Goethel was born on April 7, 1930, in Eau Claire, and died on
3	February 23, 1996, in Durand; and
4	Whereas, he was elected in November of 1958 to the assembly to represent the
5	first assembly district of Eau Claire County; and
6	Whereas, Mr. Goethel was elected in November of 1964 as District Attorney of
7	Pepin County, and was reelected to that office every 2 years since; and
8	Whereas, during his public service career as District Attorney of Pepin County,
9	Karl J. Goethel earned the respect of his legal colleagues, judges, defendants and
10	courthouse elected officials and employes as an individual of legal expertise,
11	personal integrity and honesty; and
12	Whereas, based on present records of elected district attorneys, Karl J. Goethel
13	held the distinction of being Wisconsin's longest serving district attorney; and
14	Whereas, as a lawyer and prosecutor, Karl J. Goethel demonstrated a unique
15	sense of humor and wit, which became a trademark of renown; now, therefore, be it
