3	"Section 1g. 340.01 (46m) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	340.01 (46m) (b) If the person has 2 or more prior convictions, suspensions or
5	revocations, as counted under s. 343.307 (1), or if there was a minor passenger in the
6	motor vehicle at the time of the violation, a blood alcohol concentration of 0.08% or
7	more by weight of alcohol in the person's blood or $0.08~\mathrm{grams}$ or more of alcohol in $210~\mathrm{cm}$
8	liters of the person's breath.".
9	2. Page 2, line 1: delete "1" and substitute "1m".
10	3. Page 6, line 10: after that line insert:
11	"Section 10g. 346.63 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
12	346.63 (5) (a) No person may drive or operate a commercial motor vehicle while
13	the person has an alcohol concentration of 0.04 or more but less than 0.1. If there
14	was a minor passenger in the commercial motor vehicle at the time of the violation,
15	no person may drive or operate a commercial motor vehicle while the person has an

alcohol concentration of 0.04 or more but less than 0.08.

SECTION 10m. 346.63 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

346.63 (6) (a) No person may cause injury to another person by the operation of a commercial motor vehicle while the person has an alcohol concentration of 0.04 or more but less than 0.1. If there was a minor passenger in the commercial motor vehicle at the time of the violation, no person may cause injury to another person by the operation of a commercial motor vehicle while the person has an alcohol concentration of 0.04 or more but less than 0.08.".
