(a) 2., the sheriff shall ensure that the firearm is properly maintained by a person competent to perform the maintenance work. For purposes of this paragraph, proper maintenance includes all of the following:

- 1. The cleaning and oiling of the firearm at least once every 60 days.
- 2. If the firearm is antique or rare or is otherwise similar to a museum object, the cleaning, treatment and other work necessary to preserve the firearm's finish, artwork and detailing.
- 3. If the firearm is in a leather or wood case, the cleaning, treatment and other work, done with the proper materials, necessary to maintain the case.
- (at) A sheriff to whom a firearm has been surrendered under par. (a) 2. is liable for any damage caused to that firearm, or any case in which the firearm is encased, while it is in the possession of the sheriff.".
