



**SENATE AMENDMENT 8,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 144**

September 27, 1995 - Offered by Senator ZIEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 8, line 8: after that line insert:

3 “(ar) If a sheriff has in his or her possession a firearm that has been surrendered
4 under par. (a) 2., the sheriff shall store the firearm in accordance with all of the
5 following requirements:

6 1. The firearm shall be stored in a place in which the humidity is controlled in
7 a way that ensures that the firearm will not rust or corrode.

8 2. The firearm shall be stored in a rack and on pegs that ensure that the firearm
9 will not come into contact with another firearm.

10 3. If the firearm is antique or rare or is otherwise similar to a museum object,
11 the firearm shall be stored in a manner that preserves and safeguards the firearm
12 to the same degree as the manner of storage used by the firearm’s owner.

13 (at) A sheriff to whom a firearm has been surrendered under par. (a) 2. is liable
14 for any damage caused to that firearm while it is in the possession of the sheriff.”.

15 **2.** Page 9, line 22: after that line insert:

1 “(ar) If a sheriff has in his or her possession a firearm that has been surrendered
2 under par. (a) 2., the sheriff shall store the firearm in accordance with all of the
3 following requirements:

4 1. The firearm shall be stored in a place in which the humidity is controlled in
5 a way that ensures that the firearm will not rust or corrode.
