



**SENATE AMENDMENT 9,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 270**

November 15, 1995 – Offered by Senator ADELMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 19, line 22: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 24m.** 51.20 (13) (g) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

4 51.20 (13) (g) 1. Except as provided in subd. subds. 2. and 2 c., the first order
5 of commitment of a subject individual under this section may be for a period not to
6 exceed 6 months, and all subsequent consecutive orders of commitment of the
7 individual may be for a period not to exceed one year.

8 “**SECTION 24n.** 51.20 (13) (g) 2c. of the statutes is created to read:

9 51.20 (13) (g) 2c. Any commitment ordered under par. (a) 3. to 5., following proof
10 of the allegations under sub. (1) (a) 2. e., 3., may not continue longer than 60 days in
11 any 365-day period.”.

12 **2.** Page 20, line 10: after that line insert:

13 “**SECTION 25m.** 51.20 (13) (g) 2m. of the statutes is amended to read:

14 51.20 (13) (g) 2m. In addition to the provisions under subds. 1., 2. 2c. and 2g.,
15 no commitment ordered under par. (a) 4. or 4m. may continue beyond the inmate’s
16 date of release as determined under s. 302.11.

SECTION 25n. 51.20 (13) (g) 2r. of the statutes is amended to read:

51.20 (13) (g) 2r. Twenty-one days prior to expiration of the period of commitment under subd. 1., 2., 2c. 2g. or 2m., the department, if the individual is committed to the department, or the county department to which an individual is committed shall file an evaluation of the individual and the recommendation of the department or county department regarding the individual's recommitment with the committing court and provide a copy of the evaluation and recommendation to the individual's counsel and the counsel designated under sub. (4). If the date for filing an evaluation and recommendation under this subdivision falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the date which is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday and which most closely precedes the evaluation and recommendation filing date shall be the filing date. A failure of the department or the county department to which an individual is committed to file an evaluation and recommendation under this subdivision does not affect the jurisdiction of the court over a petition for recommitment.”.
