# SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 SENATE BILL 364 

November 7, 1995 - Offered by Senators Adelman and Burke.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 4: after that line insert:
"(d) "Public trust purpose" has the meaning given in section 13.097 (1) (c) of the statutes.".
2. Page 3, line 13: after that line insert:
"(6) Report. (a) The department shall prepare a report on the authorization under subsection (2) within 15 days after the effective date of this subsection. The report shall contain all of the following:
3. The purpose of the proposed filled area.
4. Opportunities for navigation, fishing, hunting, swimming, recreation, enjoyment of scenic beauty and other public trust purpose uses that will be lost or obtained when the city of Appleton exercises the rights authorized by this act.
5. The type of uses that will be made of the area to be filled when the city of Appleton exercises the rights authorized by this act and whether those uses are public trust purpose uses.
6. Proposed restrictions on public access upon completion of the heritage park, including physical restrictions such as fences, walls or lack of parking, legal restrictions such as hours of operation or conversion to private property and financial restrictions such as admission fees, licenses, permits or requirements to make purchases.
7. What management controls are proposed by the city of Appleton to ensure that the city complies with subsections (2) and (4).
8. Whether any commercial uses of the area to be filled are minor and incidental to free public trust purpose uses or whether commercial purposes dominate the proposed use of the area to be filled.
(b) The department may request the city of Appleton to provide the department with any information that is reasonably necessary for the department to prepare the report under this subsection.".
