



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 437**

March 7, 1996 – Offered by Representatives GOETSCH and WOOD.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute  
2           amendment 1, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 2, line 7: delete lines 7 and 8 and substitute:

4           “**SECTION 3g.** 946.68 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 946.68 (1r) (a) and  
5           amended to read.”.

6           **2.** Page 2, line 9: delete “(1)” and substitute “(1r)”.

7           **3.** Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:

8           “**SECTION 3r.** 946.68 (1g) of the statutes is created to read:

9           946.68 (1g) In this section, “legal process” means a document issued by a court  
10          for the purpose of exercising jurisdiction over a person or a person’s property or for  
11          the purpose of directing a person to appear before the court or to perform or refrain  
12          from performing a specified act. “Legal process” includes a summons, complaint,  
13          warrant, injunction, writ, notice, pleading, subpoena or order.”.

14          **4.** Page 2, line 14: delete “(1)” and substitute “(1r)”.

15          **5.** Page 2, line 15: delete “(1)” and substitute “(1r)”.
