



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 437**

January 11, 1996 – Offered by Senator ADELMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: before “criminal” insert “paramilitary training.”

3 **2.** Page 1, line 7: delete that line and substitute:

4 “**SECTION 1g.** 21.10 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **21.10 Paramilitary training prohibited.** (1) In this section:

6 (a) “Military weapon” includes all of the following:

7 1. A firearm.

8 2. A device capable of discharging a projectile by means of a gas generated from  
9 an explosive compound.

10 3. An explosive or incendiary bomb, grenade, rocket, missile or similar device.

11 4. A device for launching an explosive or incendiary bomb, grenade, rocket,  
12 missile or similar device.

13 (b) “Paramilitary organization” means an organization of 2 or more persons  
14 who engage or conspire to engage in military instruction or training in warfare or

1 sabotage for the purpose of unlawfully causing bodily harm to any person or  
2 unlawfully damaging the property of any person.

3 (2) No person may, with knowledge of the purpose of the paramilitary  
4 organization, assemble or conspire to assemble with other persons as a paramilitary  
5 organization and practice with a military weapon in order to further the purpose of  
6 the paramilitary organization.

7 (3) A person who violates sub. (2) may be fined not more than \$10,000 or  
8 imprisoned for not more than 2 years or both.

9 SECTION 1r. 409.404 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:”.
