| 9 | (b) "Institution of higher education" means a center or institution within the |
| 10 | University of Wisconsin System, a technical college or a private, nonprofit institution |
| 11 | of higher education located in this state. |
| 12 | (2) Any person engaged in the sale or use of commercial equipment or |

technology, for profit or not for profit, who donates any commercial equipment or

technology to a public or private elementary or secondary school or an institution of

- higher education or who accepts reimbursement in an amount not to exceed overhead and transportation costs for any commercial equipment or technology provided to a public or private elementary or secondary school or to an institution of higher education is immune from civil liability for the death of or injury to an individual caused by the commercial equipment or technology.
- (3) This section does not apply if the death or injury was caused by a wilful or wanton act or omission of the person who donated or accepted reimbursement for the commercial equipment or technology.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to commercial equipment or technology donated or for which reimbursement was accepted on the effective date of this subsection.
