## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 6, TO 1995 SENATE BILL 563

March 27, 1996 - Offered by Representatives DOBYNS and ROBSON.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2	amendment 1, as follows:
3	${f 1.}$ Page 1, line 11: after the semicolon insert: "bulletproof garments for state
4	traffic patrol officers and motor vehicle inspectors;".
5	<b>2.</b> Page 3, line 21: after that line insert:
6	<b>"SECTION 3g.</b> 110.07 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	110.07 (3) The secretary may employ inspectors who may not wear the uniform
8	of the state patrol, whose duties shall be to enforce and assist in administering s.
9	346.63, this chapter and chs. 194, 218, 340 to 345 and 347 to 351, s. 23.33, the
10	inspection requirements of s. 121.555 $\left(2\right)\left(b\right)$ and the requirements under s. 346.45
11	(4) for vehicles being used to transport hazardous materials. Such inspectors, in the
12	performance of these duties, shall have the powers and authority of state traffic
13	officers. For the purpose of death, disability and retirement coverage, such
14	inspectors shall be subject to ch. 40 as is the state traffic patrol. The <u>Subject to sub.</u>
15	(5), the secretary may clothe and equip inspectors as the interest of public safety and
16	their duties require.

SECTION 3m. 110.07 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
110.07 (5) (a) In this subsection, "bulletproof garment" has the meaning given
in s. 939.64 (1).

4 (b) Upon request of an officer of the state traffic patrol under sub. (1) or  $\mathbf{5}$ inspector under sub. (3), the department shall make available to the traffic officer or 6 inspector a bulletproof garment that may be used in the performance of his or her 7 duties under this section. The department shall equip a traffic officer or inspector 8 with a bulletproof garment as soon as practicable after receipt of the request from 9 the traffic officer or inspector under this paragraph, provided that each traffic officer or inspector who has made a request before September 1, 1997, shall be equipped 10 11 with a bulletproof garment by that date.".
